Staff

All summer staff members are licensed by the Office of Child Care Services, which includes current CPR and First Aid certifications.

Tuition and Payments

- Regular Day from 8:00 AM - 3:00 PM is \$165/week.
- Extended Day from 8:00 AM - 5:30 PM is \$225/week.
- Part time enrollment 3 days/week & 2 days/week
- Payments are due in full by the Friday before the enrolled week.
- There is a 5% discount for full summer enrollment.
- A 10% discount for siblings is given for concurrent weeks of enrollment.
- A late pick up fee of \$1/5 minutes per child applies.

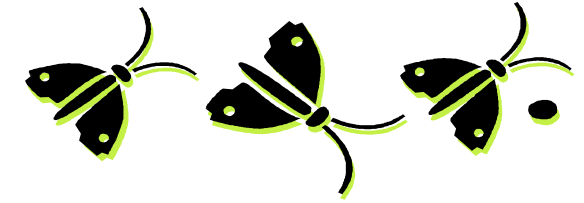
